About the venue

Welcome to the Corn Exchange!

This is a visual resource for audience members living with dementia, their carers and friends. Here you will find everything you need to know about your visit.

This is the Corn Exchange building.

The doors to the Corn Exchange are made of glass with stainless steel long handles that open both ways.




Directly inside the doors to your <u>right</u> you can find our box office where you can buy or collect your ticket.



To the left of the box office is our Bar where you can buy a drink or snack.

If you would like to take the lift to the cinema you can find the lift on the <u>left</u> of the foyer. If you need a bathroom, they can also be found on this floor, they are circled yellow.



The lift looks like this:



Once inside push 2 for the cinema floor:



If you would like to take the stairs, they are located next to the lift and are marked


with a sign.



There are two flights of stairs, at the top of the second flight you will see a sign for the cinema.



There is a door to go through at this point, once through the door, turn <u>right</u> and you will see the doors to the cinema.



Welcome to the cinema where your screening will take place. The lights will be on but turned down a little for the duration of the performance making it easy to leave at any time. There will be no trailers shown before the film takes place and the sound will not be turned up too loud, there are no loud or sudden noises in the film and there will be a short comfort break in the middle of the screening (after approximately 45 minutes).



If you have any worries or queries during your visit, look for people wearing these lanyards around their neck, they are all Dementia Friends and will be able to help you.
